



Announcement: Acting Principal Appointment



The Board of Directors is pleased to announce the appointment of Mr. Oliver Fisher to the position of Acting Principal for the 2018-19 school year.

Mr. Fisher has been a teacher at the Calgary Girls' School since its opening in 2003. He was a designated learning leader in 2008 and then appointed to the position of Vice Principal in 2009. Previous to his employment with the Calgary Girls' School he worked for the Calgary Board of Education.

Mr. Fisher's experience and academic credentials have prepared him for the leadership role as Principal. He has several years of experience teaching a variety of subjects and disciplines in all elementary and middle / junior high grades. He holds a Bachelor of Education, Master of Teaching from the University of Calgary, a Bachelor of Arts (Psychology Major) from Lakehead University and most recently he completed his Masters of Education in educational leadership from the University of Calgary.

He is a "keeper of the vision" of the Calgary Girls' School as evidenced most recently by his leadership in the refreshing of the Go Girls curriculum, a locally developed course for all grades 4-9. It is through Go Girls that our school promotes the development of competent, caring, and connected girls and young women.

Mr. Fisher is committed to the vision and mission of the Calgary Girls' School and recognizes the importance of achieving the priorities outlined in the Three -Year Education Plan. He will continue the work on Go Girls, technology strategy, numeracy, and assessment.
