Background

Canada is a nation of two official languages, English and French. Thus, the Calgary Girls Charter School offers both English and French language instruction.

Procedures

- 1. French as a Second Language (FSL) is offered in accordance with the Program of Studies and relevant FSL curriculum documents.
- 2. In scheduling French programs, the Principal is expected to follow the recommendations for time allotment and frequency of instruction noted in the Guide to Education.
- 3. FSL may be a mandatory program for students in grades 4-6, but is offered as an elective (option) for junior high aged students (middle grades 7-9).
