



Background

Procedures

2. Selection of recipients shall be based upon pre-determined criteria.
3. Funds held in trust at the school shall be managed in accordance with:
 - 3.1 Conditions agreed upon at time of establishment; and
 - 3.2 Current school procedures.
4. Donors shall be appropriately acknowledged.
