



Background

A clear organizational structure supports efficient and effective operations. A graphic representation is helpful in clarifying working relationships. The organizational structure reflects differences in responsibility, accountability and authority for decision-making.

Procedures:

1. The Superintendent develops an organizational structure and communicates the structure to all employees.
2. The structure outlines working relationships where each employee will have one supervisor.
3. Direction shall follow the organizational structure.
